Firstly Raoul Servais, our former ASIFA President created the opening credits.

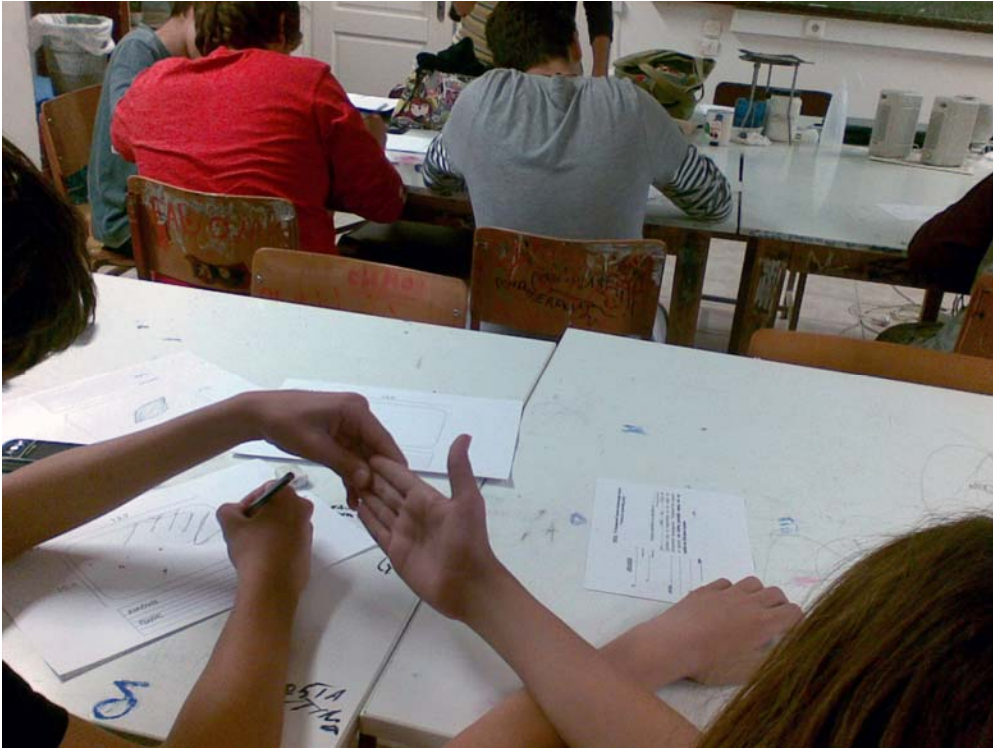
